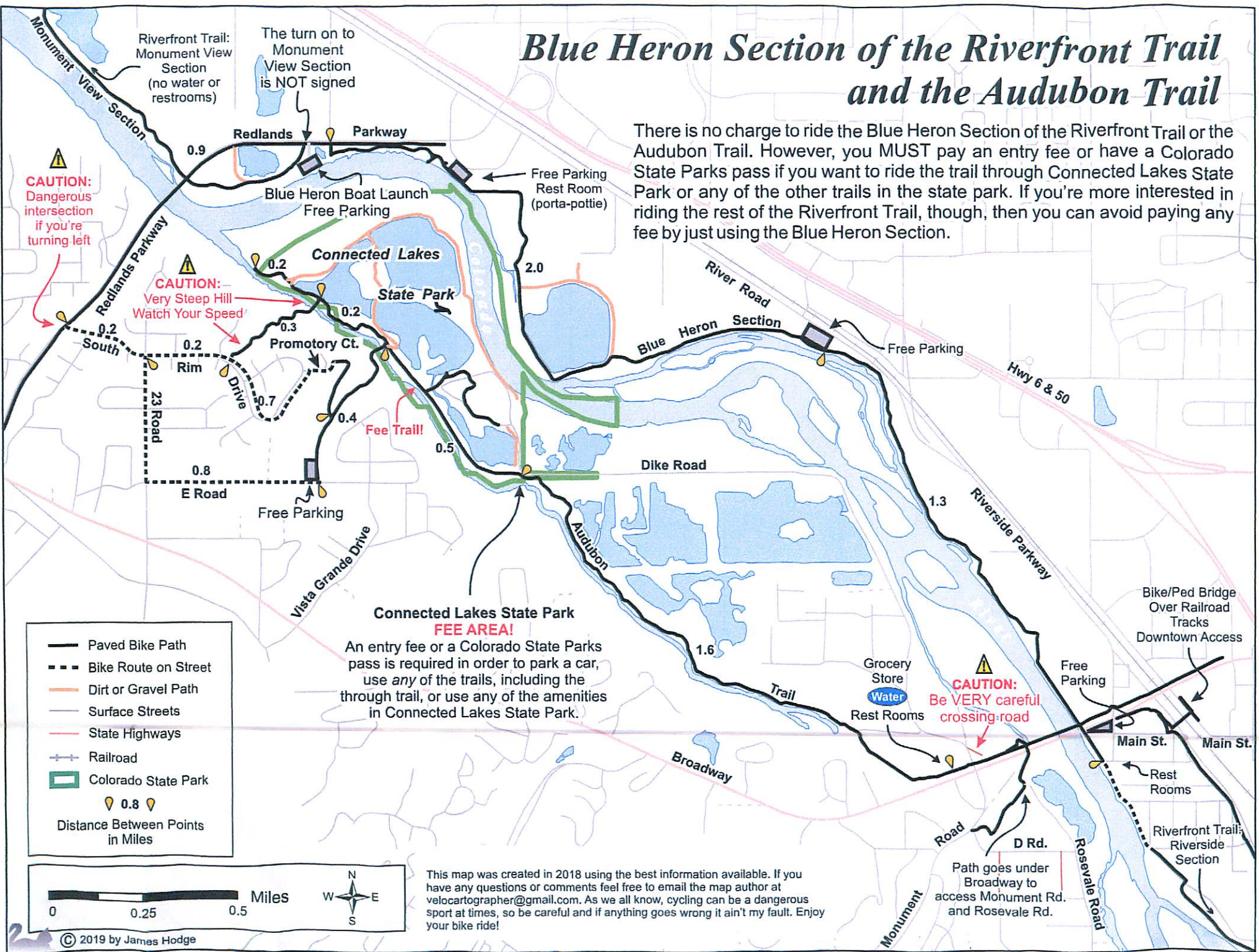


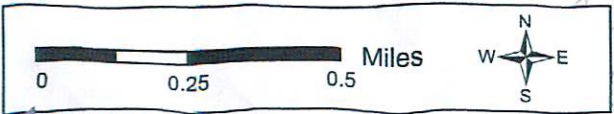
Blue Heron Section of the Riverfront Trail and the Audubon Trail

There is no charge to ride the Blue Heron Section of the Riverfront Trail or the Audubon Trail. However, you MUST pay an entry fee or have a Colorado State Parks pass if you want to ride the trail through Connected Lakes State Park or any of the other trails in the state park. If you're more interested in riding the rest of the Riverfront Trail, though, then you can avoid paying any fee by just using the Blue Heron Section.
